



CITY OF BROOKS

BYLAW NO. 19/02

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF BROOKS, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 16/22, BEING A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH THE RECREATION AND PARKS BOARD.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend Bylaw No. 16/22 being a Bylaw to establish the Recreation and Parks Board to allow two (2) additional County of Newell members-at-large to serve on the Board.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Brooks duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Section 301 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 301. Not more than four (4) citizens-at-large of the City of Brooks appointed by the Council of the City of Brooks.
2. That Section 302 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 302. Not more than five (5) representatives from the County of Newell; two (2) of whom shall be County of Newell Division 5 & 10 Councillors and three (3) members-at-large, appointed by the Council of the County of Newell.
3. That Section 306 be added to the Bylaw to read:
 306. Not more than one (1) youth citizen-at-large position of either the City of Brooks or County of Newell appointed by the Council of the applicable municipality.
4. That the previous Section 306 be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 307. The citizen-at-large members of the Board may serve for up to three (3) consecutive two (2) year terms. Members having served three (3) consecutive two (2) year terms shall not be reappointed without an absence from the Board for at least one (1) year. The Council of the appointed member shall have the right to waive the required absence at its sole discretion, upon receiving a request to do so from the Board. The youth citizen-at-large member may serve for up to two (2) consecutive one (1) year terms.
5. That the remaining Sections be renumbered accordingly.
6. That this Bylaw shall take effect upon final passing thereof.
