Return to Use – Walking Track at the Centennial Regional Arena

The purpose of this document is to communicate practices in place to minimize the risk of transmission of COVID-19 during the re-opening of the City of Brooks Centennial Regional Arena walking track. We ask for your cooperation as we work to maintain a safe user space. Please review the guidance below.

Welcome Back: We look forward to welcoming back the community to our track under the new guidelines and facility procedures. Your collaboration and communication is very important as we work through the reopening of our indoor track at the Centennial Regional Arena. The health and safety of everyone is our priority and if you have any questions, please let us know.

Physical Distancing: Maintain at least a 2-meter distance between you and others not of the same household or core cohort. If a 2-meter distance cannot be maintained, masks must be worn. A 3-meter distance is recommended for high intensity activity.

Limit Contact: Capacities will be used to reduce the risk of exposure and transmission through droplets in the air during track use. Children are not permitted on the track at this time. Track capacities are listed below.

- ✓ Running Max – 5 Participants
- ✓ Stroller Time Max – 5 Participants
- ✓ Seniors Walk Max – 15 Participants
- ✓ Lunch Hour Walk – 15 Participants
- ✓ Book Your Timeslot – Social distancing and/or cohort guidelines apply

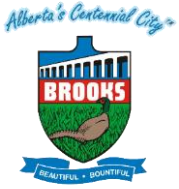
The CRA walking track is closed while we are accommodating spectators for ice rentals.

Pre-Screening measures: Do not enter the facility if you feel ill and/or present any symptoms for COVID-19. Stay home and complete the online self-assessment tool. Follow screening tools outlined by your organizations and AHS.

Contact Tracing: All track participants should sign their name and phone number on the contact tracing forms before entry.

Cleaning & Sanitizing: In addition to routine facility cleaning protocols, we have increased the frequency of sanitizing commonly touched surfaces.

Arrival & Departure: All guests are expected to use the hand sanitizer provided at the entrance. Please arrive/exit no more than 5 minutes from your scheduled activity time.



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Additional Details: Please bring your own water bottle. Water fountains are closed due to the nature of their use. However, bottle filling stations remain open. Concourse bathrooms are closed, please use the lobby bathrooms.

Following Guidelines: Compliance with the above guidelines is critical in maintaining the health and safety of our customers, users and employees. Failure to comply with the guidelines will result in a loss of privilege to use City of Brooks recreation facilities.

The JBS Canada Centre fieldhouse is open for walking from 6am – 8:30am (15 Capacity)
